### **Drum Clamps**

Drum Clamp - Forklifts are meant to handle storing, lifting and moving pallets. For facilities which deal with items in drums, you must use an attachment to move, lift and store them. There are several drum forklift accessories which you could get for all of your drum lifting needs. These attachments are specifically meant so as to handle drum containers - hence there is no chance of damage to the item or drum container when they are moved, lifted or stored.

### Drum Positioner And Grab

The drum positioner is presented in three and four tine models. They are utilized for the unloading and loading of drums off drum stands, racks and vehicles. This accessory is fully automatic, thus enabling the the one operating it to operate all from the comfort of the lift truck seat. Able to move steel, large and extra large plastic drums, its capacity is 210 liters. This accessory is intended for drum pyramid stacking.

The drum grab is fork designed and mounted with the sole purpose of dealing with steel drums that have rolling hoops. Although the reason for the design was to handle steel drums with rolling hoops, the drum grab can accommodate the transporting of extra large and large plastic drums. Drum capacity maximum is 210 liters for steel drums with rolling hoops and 220 liters for plastic drums.

## The Rotator

The drum rotator is a lift truck accessory which mounts on to the blades themselves. The objective of the drum rotator is to pick up the drum and rotate it upside down. The drum fits in to the rotator utilizing a steel clamp that fits over the middle of the drum. The rotation is executed by either a continuous loop chain or a crank handle. The crank handle is designed for operations that take place beneath shoulder level. For operations which should happen higher than shoulder level, the continual circle chain will be used.

Drum tines are simple fork mounted attachment which could be utilized for stacking and unstacking 210-liter metal drums. Stacking requires nothing intricate, just easy horizontal placement of the drums. The carriage-mounted enhancements lessen the load center of the drums.

## **Automatic Tongs**

Drum tongs are available in automatic and semi-automatic versions. They are utilized in the open topped or tight head steel drum kinds. The drum pincers could be connected in several ways to the lift truck. One way is to attach them beneath a fork-mounted hook. One more way is to connect them to a fork-mounted jib or a carriage mounted jib. Either the semi automatic and the automatic have a drum capacity of 210 liters. With the automatic, there is no requirement for the person operating it to ever leave the seat of the lift truck.

# Rim Grip Handler

The Rip Grip Drum Handler is the perfect alternative for forklift accessories, whenever there is a need to stockpile drums with limited area accessible. This particular attachment can be utilized on both 120L and 210L drums. The Rim Grip Handler functions by utilizing metal jaws in order to grab the edge of the drum. It picks the drum up and sets it down without needing any space between all of the drums. The average unit utilized in the trade is a zinc-plated handler, even though, this accessory comes accessible in stainless steel for the food and drink industry.
